

House Rules of Kodokan Hostel

Kodokan hostel is to offer accommodations for those who have Judo training at Kodokan. All residents must adhere to these rules, respect the spirit of Kodokan Judo, observe good manners, and not make a nuisance to other guests.

Qualifications / requirements for hostel use:

1. Kodokan membership holders
2. For Judo training purposes such as attending regular training sessions, winter or summer courses, seminars, tournaments, meetings and the like at Kodokan
3. Judo trainees for purposes other than the above

Room rates:

Single room (without bath)	¥3,500/night/person
Special single room (with bath)	¥5,000/night/person
Special twin room (with bath)	¥9,000/night/room
Dormitory room (without bath)	¥1,800/night/person
Extra bed	¥1,800/night

Reservations:

We start accepting your reservations 3 months ahead of your desired dates of stay. We may ask you to follow our instructions about room allotments if it is necessary after your reservation has been made.

Hostel rules:

You are requested to read through and abide by the following.

- Persons under 18 years of age may stay at the hostel only when they are accompanied by a parent or an adult leader.

- The maximum period of stay is 3 months: special permission is necessary for a further extension.
- Please advise the international department beforehand of your estimated check-in time. Our official check-in and check-out times are as follows:
 - Check-in: between 3:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.
 - Check-out: by 10:00 a.m.
- Please return your room keys to the security office on the basement upon check-out. You are to be charged with ¥5,000 for compensation in case of a lost key.
- Please pay your room charges at the international department upon arrival (only Japanese yen in cash; no credit cards are accepted).
- Curfew: midnight
(Please use the basement entrance of the office building between 10:00 p.m. and midnight.)
- Visitors are only allowed in the 3rd floor lounge space before 10:00 p.m.
- Shared bathrooms are available between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- Please handle furniture and fixtures of the hostel room with care. The guest who causes damage to them on purpose or by accident will have to make full restitution for the damage.
- Please do not cause any nuisance to other fellow guests.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the hostel and allowed only in smoking space on the 8th floor.
- Carrying easily inflammable and explosive objects into the room are prohibited.
- In case of fire, please report to the security office on the basement (ext. # 982). Evacuation route from your room is shown on the back of your door. Please make sure of the route upon check-in.
- Evacuation area in an emergency is in front of the police box at Kasuga-cho

intersection.

Tips for your stay:

- There is no meal provided at the hostel. You can eat out or at a restaurant on the basement.
- A common kitchen on the basement is available from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Please pick up a kitchen key at the security office on the basement.
When you use fire in the kitchen, please handle it with care.
- Coin-operated washing machines are available on the 3rd and 4th floors. You may hang out to dry your laundries on the rooftop or use coin-operated drying tumblers nearby the hostel.
- We do not have around-the-clock switchboard operators. The guests staying in special single or twin rooms may be able to receive phone calls through the international department only during the office hours (9:30am – 5:30pm on weekdays); for the guests staying in dormitory and single rooms, the international department may only be able to pass messages.
- Please use public phones for making phone calls. The nearest public phones for domestic calls are on the 3rd and 4th floors, and ones for international calls are on the 1st floor of the hostel and a phone box in front of the hostel.
- We offer the wireless LAN service in the hostel lobby. Guests with wireless LAN access can use this service for free.
- Foreign exchange is available at Mitsubishi UFJ Bank located on the corner of Kasuga-cho crossing between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on weekdays.
- Cash advance services of major international credit cards are available at ATMs of the post office in Bunkyo Civic Center Building (9:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. on weekdays/ 9:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. on Saturdays) and at ATM of Seven Eleven nearby.
- Kodokan Shop is open from 10:00 a.m. - 1:00p.m. / 2:00p.m. - 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
